Documentary

Rarely seen since its original release, capturing 'The Big Yin' on and off stage during his 1975 tour of Ireland, *Big Banana Feet* is a captivating record of Billy Connolly on the cusp of international fame.

Featuring iconic stand-up material alongside fascinating behind-the-scenes footage, this milestone of British comedy has been lovingly restored in 2K from original 16mm materials, reaffirming the warmth and genius that has endeared Connolly to generations of fans.

MADE IN ENGLAND: POWELL & PRESSBURGER (12A)

In BAFTA-winner David Hinton's wonderful, captivating documentary, a must for cineastes, Scorsese explains his lasting love of films like *The Life and Death of Colonel Blimp*, *Black Narcissus* and *The Red Shoes*.

Drawing on archive material, he explores the collaboration between Powell and Pressburger – two romantics and idealists, who crafted subversive, richly distinctive films that counter-intuitively thrived in the face of adversity during WWII – and their continuing influence on his own directorial style.

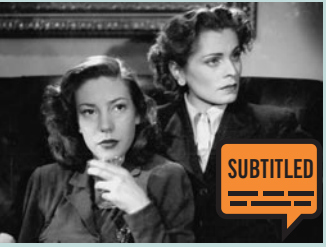
THE FALL GUY (12A)

Now, fresh off an almost career-ending accident, this working-class hero has to track down a missing movie star, solve a conspiracy and try to win back the love of his life while still doing his day job. What could possibly go right? Blending action, comedy, romance, and a pair of marvellously matched stars while both celebrating and sending up the unsung heroes of cinema, *The Fall Guy* is a delightfully good time.

Austin Butler (*Elvis*), Jodie Comer (*Killing Eve*) and Tom Hardy (*Dunkirk*, *The Dark Knight Rises*) lead an all-star ensemble cast in the latest from writer-director Jeff Nichols (*Loving*, *Midnight Special*).

An exhilarating, full-throttle period drama, it's derived from Danny Lyon's 1967 photography study of Midwest bikers and pays clear tribute to classic films (*The Wild One*, *Easy Rider*) exploiting the iconic cool of the motorbike as a potent American symbol of individual freedom.

Inspired by the Outlaws MC, the Chicago-based motorcycle club Lyon's book captured, it follows the inner world of fictional club 'the Vandals'. Seen through the lives of its members – chiefly storyteller Kathy (Comer), smouldering Benny (Butler) and melancholic Jonny (Hardy) – we follow the club over the course of a decade, as a love triangle spools out and newcomers join the Vandals, prompting an intense power struggle.

This summer, action has a new name: June Squibb.

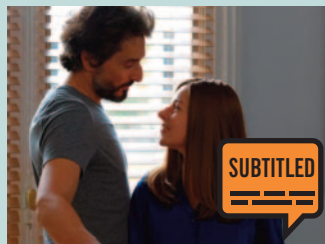
The celebrated US screen actress and Oscar-nominated star of *Nebraska*, Squibb takes centre stage – in a starring role for the first time at 94, and doing most of her own stunts – in Josh Margolin's acclaimed action comedy about a grandmother refusing to accept the limitations of age. *Thelma* also features the final performance of trailblazing actor Richard Roundtree (*Shaft*).

When Thelma Post (Squibb) is duped by a phone scammer pretending to be her grandson (*The White Lotus*'s Fred Hechinger), she sets out on a treacherous quest across Los Angeles – accompanied by an ageing friend (Roundtree) and his motorised scooter – to reclaim what is hers.

Brilliantly performed by Squibb, sincere, sensitive and very funny, *Thelma* also makes real points about the experience of ageing in a world that constantly underestimates the elderly... at its own peril.

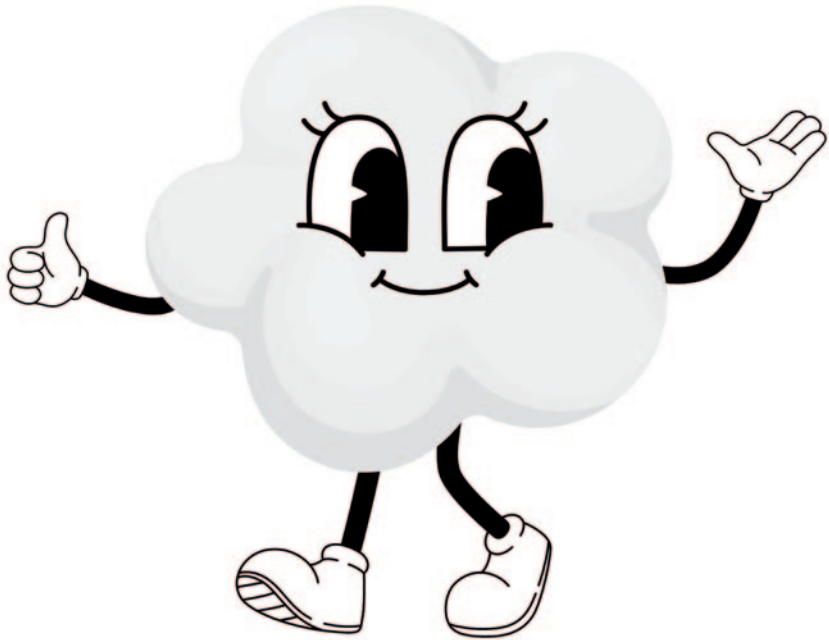
