I'm Still Here sees the Paiva family shattered when Ernesto is abducted by the military junta and Eunice (Torres) must lead their family in a lengthy fight for justice.

ERNEST COLE: LOST AND FOUND (15)

Dir: Raoul Peck | USA, France | 2024 | 106 mins | Documentary Following a UK exhibition of South African photographer's Ernest Cole's ground-breaking photobook *House of Bondage* – one of the most significant photographic works of the 20th century, which exposed the inhumanity and injustice of South African apartheid to the world – Oscar-nominated director Raoul Peck's (*I Am Not Your Negro*) new documentary takes his story to film. Narrated by actor LaKeith Stanfield, *Ernest Cole: Lost and Found* is filled with images of the acutely painful photographs Cole risked his life to take; psychological portraits of existence within a brutal caste system, its misery, violence and indignity.
